Organism-	A living thing.
Shelter-	a place that provides animals protection from other animals and weather
Nutrients-	plant food found in soil
Pollution-	contamination of water, air, or land with garbage, noise, or chemicals.
Disposable-	made to be thrown away after use
Aquatic-	growing or living in or often found in water
