### <u>Augusta Canal National Heritage Area</u> <u>Special Event Rules and Procedures</u>

#### **Event Rules and Reservations Request Form**

The Augusta Canal National Heritage Area (ACNHA) has become a popular place for organized runs, walks and similar events. Various parts of the Augusta Canal National Heritage Area are under the control of different organizations, so, depending on which areas you are using, you may also need to contact them. They are listed at the bottom of this document.

To use the Towpath, trails or canal waterway follow the rules and complete the event information form below.

#### **Rules**

Access can be denied for future events if these rules are not followed. Pass this information along to anyone that will be driving a vehicle or managing a station in the ACNHA.

- 1. Access: <u>Do not block</u> any area at any time as there are individual users of all ages every day, including bikers, joggers, and walkers. Always be considerate of others using trails and parking area. Be aware that motor vehicles from Augusta Utilities or Augusta Canal Authority may be on the trail for official purposes.
- 2. Vehicles are not allowed on the towpath without a permit.
  - a) Permits are only issued if absolutely necessary.
  - b) Vehicles are never permitted to drive across the footbridge just below the Headgates.
- 3. <u>Trash</u> From event must be removed at the end of the event.
- 4. <u>Signs</u> for the event can be placed in the ACNHA the morning of the event but must be taken down immediately after the event.
- 5. <u>Alcohol</u> is not allowed in the ACHNA at any time.
- 6. Restrooms/Portable Toilets: There are outdoor restrooms and port-o-lets along the canal for individual users. Please restock the toilet paper if your participants will be using them. If your event is larger than 45 people you will need to rent additional port-o-lets. Our preferred vendor is Scotty Potty 706-592-5685.
