Isthmus	a narrow area of land that connects two larger land areas
Lock	a short confined section of a canal or other waterway in which the water level can be changed by the use of gates and sluices, used for raising and lowering vessels between two gates.
Maritime	of or relating to sailing on the sea or doing business (such as trading) by sea
Province	any one of the large parts that some countries are divided into
Sluice gate	a gate that opens to allow water to flow in and out of locks.
Turbine	machines that use water or steam to produce motion.
